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
## A LAND OF HEROIC VITICULTURE

A heroic viticulture flourishes on its volcanic soils, free of phylloxera, which originated more than twenty million years ago from a myriad eruptive processes triggered in the depths of the Atlantic Ocean.

Under varied climatic conditions and embraced by the trade winds, many local grape varieties grow which are unique in the world. Moreover, our wine culture cannot be understood without regard to the fact that the Canary Islands were a strategic point during European modern expansion and, for centuries, one of the main winemaking areas in the world.







Our team at Viñátigo shares a common purpose: a commitment to convey the true essence of the Canary Islands. From recovering local grape varieties on the verge of extinction and carefully mapping our soil types to ensuring integrity in the winemaking process—our aim remains the same.

## BODEGAS VIÑÁTIGO

Creating an authentic wine is a combination of a series of elements, which start at the vineyard and remain present throughout its transformation in the winery. We believe it is essential that this process operates seamlessly, therefore we apply this philosophy to our winery as rigorously as we do to our vineyards.

### AN INTEGRATED ARCHITECTURE

We prefer to adapt to the environment that surrounds us rather than trying to force the environment to adapt to us. The results of this strategy are astonishing. To this, we use natural rocks to build the foundations that make our vineyards so unique. By taking advantage of the natural ventilation provided by the northern winds and the gravity, we allow the grapes to pass through the winery as naturally as possible.

# GRAPE VARIETIES FROM THE CANARY ISLANDS



Historically, the Canary Islands were a stopping point for expeditions to the Americas. As a result, there is an incredible number of grape varieties, most of which are now unique to the Islands. These grape varieties are part of the identity, the heritage and, in a nutshell, the future of the Canary Islands. Our «Varietales de Canarias» collection is a celebration of our winemaking heritage—we produce single-varietal wines of each of these exceptional local grape varieties.



## «ENSAMBLAJES» COLLECTION



This is a small yet significant collection of wines, which is proof of the unique microclimate of the north-western area of Tenerife and the high concentration of its volcanic soils. By combining our unique grape varieties we display the volcanic terroir of this special part of the island—its wines are smoky, strong and intense.

Both wines are, for us, the genuine expression of local varieties that serve to identify our environment: the north-western area of Tenerife.



# «ELABORACIONES ANCESTRALES» COLLECTION



We can only advance into the future by revisiting the past. The Canary Islands have a six-hundred-year winemaking history. By implementing some of the ancestral winemaking methods of our ancestors, we reveal the true nature of our local vines.





The Pét-Nat or pétillant naturel, also known as ancestral wine, is a sparkling wine that only undergoes a primary fermentation and is bottled before this fermentation is finished. In this manner, it becomes bubbly thanks to the grapes' own sugar, which distinguishes it from better-known sparkling drinks that go through a secondary fermentation that happens after sugar is added to produce the bubbles.





## SINGLE-VINEYARD WINES



Since the 1990s, Bodegas Viñátigo has adhered to its beliefs and convictions, focusing on working with and recovering local pre-phylloxera grape varieties. Having carried out this task for so many years could only be possible by remaining constantly faithful to the idea of building an identity for our wines based on these local grape varieties, which are unique in the world. For this reason, from 2017 a new collection of single-vineyard wines is created with the purpose of highlighting the sense of place and the unique nature of each environment, hence respecting traditional vineyard systems and landscapes of historical vine-growing interest on the Island of Tenerife.










We produce these single-vineyard wines from vineyards which are located on the northern and north-western areas of Tenerife. The northern slope of our Island, with its hilly relief, takes advantage from the trade winds, which confer freshness and acidity to our wines. Along with this, the heterogeneity that we find in our soils and the combination of different cultures and influences in the process of colonisation, generate an extraordinary and vast vine-growing map that is unique in the world.





## OUR VINEYARDS

We believe it is only possible to make a great wine from great grapes, and Tenerife's volcanic soils have a key role to play when it comes to the unique style of our wines. Over the last twenty years, we have been carefully planting grape varieties of our Islands in specific vineyards, finding the perfect microclimate and soil for each one of them.
